Installation & Training includes but is not limited to:

Unpacking, assembly, and fine tuning unit if necessary such as nip and pressure adjustment, instruction on the safety features and their operation, laminator controls and their use, webbing the unit, application training, cleaning and periodic maintenance.

- Single Sided PS Laminating of cut sheets using Kraft paper or Sled
(Kraft Paper or Mounting board to match PSA film required)
- Decaling using PS Laminate and Mounting adhesive (Optional 300/400/500/800)
(PSA film and Mounting adhesive to match PSA film required)
- Mounting an Image to a substrate
(Mounting boards @ 24 x 36" required)
- Encapsulation (800 Series Only. Lo-Temp Laminate 2 rolls same size required)
